

**AIMS Luncheon

AIMS is bringing one of the most interesting people on the Quebec political scene to Atlantic Canada.

As leader of the *Action démocratique du Québec* (ADQ), Mario Dumont proposes the “autonomist option”, a new constitutional orientation which aims to unite all Québeckers, thus overcoming the sterile and divisive debates of the past. He also challenges the current health care system and calls for greater openness to and involvement by the private sector, thus creating a mixed public-private health system such as those prevailing in European countries.

The ADQ, which Mr. Dumont founded, is a real force in Quebec politics, and at various times has been the most popular party in Quebec. Mr. Dumont himself enjoys a strong following in the province, while espousing a political philosophy quite at odds with the conventional wisdom of the province’s political class. He is also working hard to forge good working relations with people in all parts of the country, including Atlantic Canada.

The first event is in Halifax on September 20th and the second in Moncton on the 21st.
