



AIMS 3RD ANNUAL HIGH SCHOOL REPORT CARD (RC3)

Covering school years 2000-2001 through 2002-2003

New Brunswick Anglophone High Schools

Anglophone schools in New Brunswick are assessed on a wide range of criteria. Provincial exam results in mathematics and English are combined with post-secondary achievement to compute performance on the achievement side. Retention measures for all four high school grades, as well participation in college preparatory math and English, are used to assess the engagement measure.

Two Anglophone New Brunswick schools earned A's. Once again, Sir James Dunn Academy holds the province's top ranking. This school has an outstanding track record of consistently high achievement across all domains, both in absolute terms and in context. St. Mary's Academy made a significant move up from a B to an A. Worth noting is a third school, Cambridge Narrows, which jumped from a C to a B+.

No Anglophone school in New Brunswick received a failing grade, although Southern Victoria earned a D. Its absolute performance received a failing grade, although the contextual results suggest this school faces significant challenges.

Several schools showed significant declines in grades in this year's Report Card. Caledonia Regional High School fell from a B to a C and Upper Miramichi Regional High School fell from a B+ to a C+, as did Chipman Junior/Senior High.
