- I, Bernie MacKinnon, of the Cape Breton Regional Municipality, Province of Nova Scotia, make oath and say as follows:
- 1. I am Coordinator of Human Resource Services for the Cape Breton Victoria Regional School Board (CBVRSB), and as such have personal knowledge of all the matters herein deposed to except where stated to be by way of information and belief.
- 2. The CBVRSB is a body corporate created pursuant to the *Education Act*, S.N.S. 1995-96, c.1. The CBVRSB has a mandate to deliver public education programs and services to students whose parents reside in the geographic boundaries of the Cape Breton Regional Municipality and Victoria County, which boundaries match the geographic boundaries of the CBVRSB.
- 3. On May 2, 2005, the CBVRSB received a request from the Atlantic Institute of Market Studies (AIMS) for a variety of information related to student grades, attendance and other statistics. A true copy of AIMS' request is attached at Exhibit "A".
- 4. On February 21, 2006, I advised AIMS the CBVRSB would make available what information existed at the CBVRSB schools, but stressed the information would not be

complete. I told the Review Officer with a copy of Mr. Charles Cirtwell, we would provide attendance rates, discipline statistics, postal code information and average grade nine marks at no charge for the current year and whatever was available from past years. We were unable to provide this information for the past five years as requested by AIMS.

- 5. This information was provided by the end of February, 2006.
- The CBVRSB was not able to provide all information requested by AIMS, because much 6. of the information requested did not exist.
- 7. The CBVRSB did not create any records in order to provide the above information, and did not charge any fee to ATMS.
- I make this Affidavit related to an appeal filed pursuant to Section 41 of the Freedom of 8. Information and Protection of Privacy Act, and for no other improper purpose.
