

AIMS 7th Annual High School Report Card (RC7)

New Brunswick Francophone High Schools

As was the case last year, grades remained relatively consistent for schools in the New Brunswick Francophone sector. École Marie-Gaétane, stays in the top spot for the third consecutive year, maintaining an overall grade of 'A-'. École Sainte-Anne in Fredericton ranked second, also maintaining its grade of 'B+'. Only École secondaire Népisiguit saw a change in grade of more than two levels, falling from a 'B' to a 'C+' with a small decline in many of its Achievement and Engagement measures. This also marks the first time we have enough information to grade Moncton's École L'Odyssée since its opening in the 2005-2006 school year, and it garners a 'C-'.

General

Grades are based on a three year rolling average. If a school does not have at least two years of data
for a particular measure it will not receive a grade for that measure. RC7 is based on data from the
school years 2004/05, 2005/06, and 2006/07. In instances where three years of data is not available

for an entire province, at least two years must be available and schools must have data from at least one of the two years. In New Brunswick's Francophone Sector this applies to:

- Feeder Achievement Grade 8 provincial exams were not written in the sector for the 2004-2005 school year. The Feeder Achievement Measure for RC7 is based on the 2003-2004 and 2005-2006 school years (note: since this measure is a measure of achievement prior to high school, we use the school year one year prior to the high school measures. For RC7 Feeder Achievement is based on the 2003-2004, 2004-2005, and 2005-2006 school years.)
- New Brunswick learning centres and private schools are not reported and no partial data is available for them.
