



AIMS 3RD ANNUAL HIGH SCHOOL REPORT CARD (RC3)

Covering school years 2000-2001 through 2002-2003

Prince Edward Island High Schools

The lack of an ongoing standardized testing program on Prince Edward Island limits the achievement criteria that can be assessed. The only measure available is post-secondary performance. On the engagement side, a more complete set of measures is available with assessment comprised of retention across all three grades and post-secondary participation.

In this year's performance, Kinkora Regional High School built on its strong performance from last year, improving to an A+ and again ranking as the province's top performing school. Kinkora performed well both in absolute and in context measures. The second-ranked school is new to the rankings: École Francois-Buote had a strong performance, earning a B+ overall, with a strong absolute score and a somewhat weaker score in context.

No schools on P.E.I. earned a grade below C, and only Souris Regional High School achieved this grade, slipping back from a C+ in last year's Report Card. On a more positive note, both schools that earned Cs in the last Report Card, Kensington Intermediate Senior High and Three Oaks Senior High, improved to C+.
